Although the select group nominated for the medal are all deserving of the coveted award, so that the issue remains special, only a limited number of


medals will be hallmarked during 2007. The Institute is well known for its distinguished medals, many of which have been presented during private ceremonies by dignitaries in the recipient's community such as CEOs, mayors, universities, leaders, and so forth. The Institute can formally request that this be done if you wish.

A Certificate of Authenticity will be mailed to each honoree prior to the dispatch of the medal. This official document will recognize you as **Man of the Year for 2007** who has received the gold medal in commemoration of the event. The Certificate also certifies the medal's limited issue and keepsake value. It will carry the ABI's internationally recognizable seal and signatures of the Board. Placed with the medal, the combination is sure to be the centerpiece of any showcase of treasured awards and honors.

Prof. Shalyto, I would like to stress that since the medal will be granted in limited issue worldwide during 2007, you are urged to make known your acceptance as soon as possible. We cannot guarantee your nomination after the date noted on the reservation card. The **Man of the Year Medal** is a supreme symbol of distinction. Should you decline acceptance, I kindly ask that you indicate this to me, as I would like to nominate an alternative recipient.

I look forward to your response that can be easily indicated on the enclosed card and mailed in the reply envelope. A medal is tentatively reserved for you, Prof. Shalyto, as a **2007 Man of the Year**.
